

APPLE TREE VARIETIES



Espalier combination

Latin Name: Malus

Description: Perfect for small gardens. Four varieties of apples on one tree.

Flower Colour: White flowers

Height: Prune to control height and size

Self Pollinating: Yes

Blooming Season: Early Spring

Harvest: September

Years to Fruit: 2-5yrs.

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun, in fertile, drained soil.



Combo – 2 Variety

Latin Name: malus combo 2

Description: Two delicious apples are grafted onto one plant.

Flower Colour: White

Height: Prune to control height and size

Self Pollinating: Yes

Years to Fruit: 2-5yrs.

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun, in fertile, well drained soil.



Combo - 3 Variety

Latin Name: malus combo 3

Description: 3 delicious apples are grafted onto one plant.

Flower Colour: White

Height: Prune to control height and size.

Self Pollinating: yes

Years to Fruit: 2-5yrs.

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun, in fertile, well drained soil.



“Cortland” Dwarf Apple Tree

Latin Name: Malus “Cortland”

Description: Fruit is large, deep red and keeps well. Flesh is pure white, fine-textured, crisp, aromatic and very slow to brown. Tops for sauce, pies and fresh eating. Very hardy and annually productive.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 15-20 ft.

Self Pollinating: No

Blooming Season: April

Harvesting: Mid September

Years to Fruit: 3yrs.

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun, in fertile, well drained soil.



“Empire” Dwarf Apple Tree

Latin Name: Malus “Empire”

Description: The flavor of McIntosh with the sweetness of Delicious. This productive tree is disease-resistant to fire blight and cedar apple rust.

Flower Colour: Pinkish White

Height: 12-15 ft.

Self Pollinating: Yes, but for best pollination plant another variety.

Blooming Season: April

Harvesting: Mid-September

Years to Fruit: 2-5yrs.

Planting Instructions: Grow in average, medium moisture, well-drained soil in full sun. Prefers moderately fertile, lightly acidic soil. Avoid heavy clay soils which tend to waterlog easily. Needs full sun for maximum flower and fruit production.



“Fuji” Apple Dwarf Tree

Latin Name: Malus “Fuji”

Description: Great for eating and baking. Very crisp, sweet and flavourful. A cross between Red Delicious and Ralls Genet.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 10-15ft.

Self Pollinating: No.

Blooming Season: Mid Spring

Harvest: October

Years to fruit: 2-5yrs.

Planting Instructions: Grow in average, medium moisture, well-drained soil in full sun. Prefers moderately fertile, lightly acidic soil. Avoid heavy clay soils which tend to waterlog easily. Needs full sun for maximum flower and fruit production.



“Gala” Dwarf Apple Tree

Common Name: Malus “Gala”

Description: Apples are crisp, firm and sweet tasting. They resist bruising, softening and other defects.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 10-15ft.

Self Pollinating: No. Recommendation for cross pollinating is Granny Smith.

Blooming Season: Spring

Harvest: September

Years to fruit: 2-5yrs.

Planting Instructions: Grow in average, medium moisture, well-drained soil in full sun. Prefers moderately fertile, lightly acidic waterlog easily. Needs full sun for maximum flower and fruit production.



“Granny Smith” Dwarf Apple Tree

Latin Name: Malus “Granny Smith”

Description: A late, green, tart apple.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 8-10 ft.

Self Pollinating: Yes, but will produce better with a cross-pollinator. Best pollinators are Red Delicious, Golden Delicious and Red Rome Beauty.

Blooming Season: Mid season

Harvest: Early November

Years to Fruit: 2-5 yrs.

Planting Instructions: Grow in average, medium moisture, well-drained soil in full sun. Prefers moderately fertile, lightly acidic soil. Avoid heavy clay soils which tend to waterlog easily. Needs full sun for maximum flower and fruit production.



“Honeycrisp” Dwarf Apple Tree

Latin Name: Malus “Honeycrisp”

Description: White Crisp, cream-colored flesh is mild, sweet and aromatic.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 8-10ft

Self Pollinating: No. Cross pollinate with Empire, Gala, Granny Smith or Red Delicious.

Blooming Season: Spring

Harvest: Early September

Years to Fruit: 4yrs.

Planting Instructions: Grow in average, medium moisture, well-drained soil in full sun. Prefers moderately fertile, lightly acidic soil. Avoid heavy clay soils which tend to waterlog easily. Needs full sun for maximum flower and fruit production.



“Liberty” dwarf

Latin Name: Malus “liberty”

Description: Liberty is a modern apple variety, developed for disease resistance - it has very good resistance to scab, fireblight and cedar apple rust. It has the bright white flesh and sweet "vinous" flavor which is characteristic of the "Mac", with perhaps a bit more sharpness.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 8-10ft

Self Pollinating: No

Blooming Season: May

Harvesting: October

Years to Fruit: 2-5yrs.

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun in a well-drained area.



“Red MacIntosh” Apple Dwarf Tree

Latin Name: Malus “MacIntosh”

Description: With its large size, crisp mild flavor, and glossy red and green skin, the McIntosh apple is easily recognizable and one of the most widely-enjoyed varieties.

Flower Colour: Pinkish White

Height: 15-20 ft.

Self Pollinating: Cross pollinate with a Red Delicious, Gala or any other variety.

Blooming Season: April

Harvest: September

Years to Fruit: 3-4yrs.

Planting Instructions: This tree is very drought-tolerant and adaptable to most soil types. Plant your Dwarf McIntosh apple tree in full sun, with well-drained soil, and you will be rewarded with delicious, high quality fruit.



“Mutsu” Apple Dwarf Tree

Latin Name: Malus “Mutsu”

Description: The Mutsu, or Crispin, Apple is a cross between Golden Delicious and Indo apple. Mutsu is a large and juicy acidity apple. It keeps its shape when cut and baked and can also be made into apple sauce. Excellent sweet flavor for eating fresh, particularly if you like sharper apples.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 6-9 ft.

Self Pollinating: It is a triploid variety and needs two pollination partners nearby which must both be of different varieties and able to cross-pollinate each other as well as the Mutsu.

Blooming Season: Mid April

Harvest: Early October

Years to Fruit: 2-5yrs.

Planting Instructions: This tree is very drought-tolerant and adaptable to most soil types. Plant your Dwarf McIntosh apple tree in full sun, with well-drained soil, and you will be rewarded with delicious, high quality fruit.



“Northern Spy” Apple Dwarf Tree

Latin Name: Malus “Northern Spy”

Description: Fruit is large, bright red, and exceptionally juicy, with a crisp tender texture. One of the best apples ever to grace a pie, yet delightful when eaten fresh.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 9-12 ft.

Self Pollinating: Best cross pollinators are Ginger Gold, Red Delicious or Golden Delicious.

Blooming Season: Early May

Harvest: October

Years to Fruit: 2-5yrs.

Planting Instructions: : Grow in average, medium moisture, well-drained soil in full sun. Prefers moderately fertile, lightly acidic soil. Avoid heavy clay soils which tend to waterlog easily. Needs full sun for maximum flower and

fruit production.



“Red Delicious” Dwarf Apple Tree

Latin Name: Malus “Red Delicious”

Description: America's favorite red apple is tender, crisp, juicy, and has mild flavor for fresh eating.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 10-15 ft.

Self Pollinating: Cross pollinate with Yellow Delicious, Red Jonathan or Early Harvest.

Blooming Season: Early Spring

Harvest: September

Years to Fruit: 2-5yrs.

Planting Instructions: Grow in average, medium moisture, well-drained soil in full sun. Prefers moderately fertile, lightly acidic soil. Avoid heavy clay soils which tend to waterlog easily. Needs full sun for maximum flower and

fruit production.



“Red Gravenstein” Dwarf Apple Tree

Latin Name: Malus Domestica “Red Gravenstein”

Description: Gravensteins have a distinctive flushed coloring, which begins in mid-August as a few streaks of red, and spreads to cover the whole apple by the end of the picking season

Flower Colour: White

Height: 6-9 ft.

Self Pollinating: Needs to be pollinated by another variety but cannot pollinate other varieties.

Blooming Season: Spring

Harvest: Mid September

Years to Fruit: 2-5yrs.

Planting Instructions: Gravenstein is not the easiest apple to grow, but a lot of apple enthusiasts are prepared to

keep trying because the flavor is so good! It is therefore not the best choice if it is to be your only source of garden apples, but if you already have other apple trees then Gravenstein is well worth taking a chance on.



“Yellow Delicious” Dwarf Apple Tree

Latin Name: Malus “Yellow Delicious”

Description: A Large golden apple that ripens late with a fine, sweet flavor. Home use for eating, pies, sauces, and preserves.

Flower Colour: Pinkish White

Height: 10-15ft

Self Pollinating: Yes but pollinate with Red Delicious, Red Jonathan or Early Harvest for best results.

Blooming Season: Spring

Harvest: : Late September

Years to Fruit: 2-5yrs.

Planting Instructions: Grow in average, medium moisture, well-drained soil in full sun. Prefers moderately fertile, lightly acidic soil. Avoid heavy clay soils which tend to waterlog easily. Needs full sun for maximum flower and fruit production.
