

Apricot Tree Varieties



“Harglow” Apricot Dwarf Tree

Latin Name: Prunus “Harglow”

Description: Medium-size fruit with a bright orange colour. Great for fresh eating, cooking and preserving.

Flower Colour: White

Height: Prune to control height and width

Self Pollinating: Yes

Blooming Season: late spring.

Harvest: Early July

Years to Fruit: 2-5yrs.

Freestone: Yes

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun in well drained soil.



“Puget Gold” Apricot Tree

Latin Name: Prunus Armeniaca ‘Puget Gold’

Description: The fruit of the apricot tree resembles a small, yellow peach and is used for drying, desserts, preserves and canning.

Flower Colour: White, light pink

Height: 25 ft

Self Pollinating: Yes but produces better with another pollinator

Blooming Season: Early March

Harvest: Mid-August

Years to Fruit: 2-4yrs.

Freestone: Yes

Planting Instructions: Plants do best in full sun; mildly acidic to mildly alkaline, well-drained soil.



“Scout” Apricot Tree

Latin Name: Prunus ‘Scout’

Description: Fruit is bronze gold, blushed with red. Good for canning, and jam. Fair for eating

Flower Colour: Pink

Height: 10-15 ft

Self Pollinating: yes but produces better with another pollinator

Blooming Season: Early May

Harvest: Mid August

Years to Fruit: 2-4yrs.

Freestone: Yes

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun, in well drained soil.
