"Frost" Peach Tree

Description: Freestone with a light red blush over a greenish yellow. Excellent for eating fresh or canning.

Blooming Season: Early spring

Harvest: Early August Years to Fruit: 2-3yrs.

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun and fertilize yearly. Requires regular pruning and thinning.

Description: Almost fuzzless skin over firm, creamy yellow flesh. Heavy bearing. An excellent choice for canning

and freezing, as well as fresh eating and making jams and jellies.

"Reliance" Peach Dwarf Tree

Description: Plump, golden fruits are medium size with a red blush.

"Veteran" Peach Dwarf Tree

Latin Name: Prunus Persica 'Veteran'

Description: an "old timer" well known for its extreme cold hardiness. Excellent canner and fresh

eating peach. Medium large, golden yellow fruit with hardly any red.

Flower Colour: Pink Height: 10-14 ft. Self Pollinating: Yes

Blooming Season: Mid spring

Harvest: Late August Years to fruit: 3-4yrs.

Freestone: Yes

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun, in well drained soil. Fertilize yearly.
