Pear-Espalier Combination

Latin Name: *Pyrus* Espalier Combination

Description: Perfect for small gardens. Four varieties of pears on one tree.

Flower Colour: White

Height: Prune to control height and size

Self Pollinating: Yes

Blooming Season: Early Spring

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun, in fertile, well drained soil.



Pear Combo

Latin Name: *Pyrus* Combo

Description: Four delicious pears are grafted onto one plant

Flower Colour: White

Height: 15-18 ft

Self Pollinating: Yes

Blooming Season: Early Spring

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun and fertilize yearly. Prune in winter to increase air flow for good fruit production



“Bartlett” Pear Dwarf Tree

Latin Name: *Pyrus* 'Bartlett'

Description: The Bartlett has long been a popular pear because of its dependability and flavour.

Produces flavourful, sweet, crisp fruit.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 12-20 ft.

Self Pollinating: Yes

Blooming Season: Spring

Harvest: Late August

Years to Fruit: 4-6yrs,

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun, in fertile, well drained soil.



“Clapps favorite” Dwarf Tree

Latin Name: *Pyrus* “Clapps Favorite”

Description: Large sun-yellowed pears with a red cheek. Fruit is juicy with a fine sweet texture, ideal for fresh eating and canning.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 12-15ft.

Self Pollinating: No

Blooming Season: Early Spring

Harvesting: Late August

Years to Fruit: 4-6yrs.

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun in a well-drained area.



“Conference” Pear Dwarf Tree

Latin Name: *Pyrus Communis* “conference”

Description: Produces long narrow fruit. Juicy with a relatively firm flesh and a sweet flavour. Excellent eaten as a dessert pear but also exceptional when cooked.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 13 ft.

Self Pollinating: partially self-fertile but make the ideal planting partner for another variety.

Blooming Season: April

Harvesting: Late September

Years to Fruit: 3-6yrs.

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun in a well-drained area.



“Flemish beauty” Dwarf Tree

Latin Name: *Pyrus* “Flemish Beauty”

Description: Originally known as 'Fondante de Boise' or "Sweetmeat of the Woods". The large, rounded fruits have creamy-yellow skin blushed red along with firm, creamy-white flesh that becomes meltingly tender, sweet and aromatic. Hardy and highly productive.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 10-12 ft.

Self Pollinating: No

Blooming Season: Spring

Harvesting: Mid September

Years to Fruit: 3-6yrs.

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun in a well-drained area.



“Hosui” Asian Pear

Latin Name: hosui (*Pyrus pyrifolia*) dwarf

Description: The best flavored of all Asian Pears, Hosui are very round, medium to large, and combining the flavor and sweetness of Pears with the crunchiness of crisp Apples. Their mild flavor is sweet and slightly tart.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 10-15 ft.

Self Pollinating: Yes, but will produce better with another Asian variety.

Blooming Season: Early mid season

Harvesting: September

Year to Fruit: 4-6yrs.

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun in a well drained area.



“Red Bartlett” Pear Dwarf Tree

Latin Name: *Pyrus communis* “Red Bartlett” dwarf

Description: Skin brightens to a red as it ripens. The brighter the red the sweeter the taste. Great for canning.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 12-20 ft.

Self Pollinating: Yes

Blooming Season: Spring

Harvest: Late August to early September

Years to Fruit: 4-6yrs

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun, in fertile, well drained soil



“Red bosc” Pear dwarf Tree

Latin Name: *Pyrus* “Red Bosc”

Description: The classic shapely pear. The gourd-like neck of this variety makes it easily distinguishable from others. Medium to large fruit features red skin and smooth, aromatic flesh that is juicy, sweet and tender. Perfect for eating fresh, baking or drying.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 12-15ft.

Self Pollinating: No

Blooming Season: Spring

Harvest: Late September

Years to Fruit: 4-7yrs.

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun, in fertile, well drained soil.



“Shinseiki” Pear dwarf Tree

Latin Name: *Pyrus* “Shinseiki” Asian Pear

Description: Round, medium sized, golden pear with white, sweet, crisp, and juicy flesh.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 13ft.

Self Pollinating: Yes, but produces better with another Asian variety.

Blooming Season: Spring

Harvesting: Late July to mid August

Years to Fruit: 3-4yrs.

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun in a well drained area.
