

## Plum Tree Varieties



### **Plum combo**

Latin Name: Prunus Combo Tree

Description: 2-4 varieties on plums on one tree. Great for small gardens.

Height: Prune to maintain height and size you want.

Self Pollinating: yes

Years to Fruit: 2-4yrs.

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun, in fertile, well drained soil.



### **“Beauty Plum” Dwarf Tree**

Latin Name: Prunus “Beauty Plum”

Description: Sweet flavourful plum. Red over yellow skin, amber flesh streaked with red.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 12-15 ft.

Self Pollinating: Yes

Blooming Season: Early Spring

Harvest: Late July

Years to Fruit: 2-4yrs.

Freestone: Yes

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun, in fertile, well drained soil.



### **“Blue Damson” Plum Dwarf Tree**

Latin Name: Prunus “Blue Damson”

Description: Produces heavy crops of medium-sized plums that are tart and juicy. Good for jam and jelly.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 8-10ft.

Self Pollinating: Yes

Blooming Season: Early Spring

Harvest: Late September

Years to Fruit: 2-4 yrs.

Freestone: Yes

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun. Grow in moderately fertile, moist, well-drained neutral to slightly acidic soils



### **“Green Gage” Dwarf Tree**

Latin Name: *Prunus italica* ‘Green Gage’

Description: Yellow green fruit with a rich plum-honey flavour. Great for canning, desserts or preserves.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 14-20 ft.

Self Pollinating: Yes

Blooming Season: Early Spring

Harvest: Early August

Years to Fruit: 3-6yrs.

Freestone: yes

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun, in fertile, well drained soil.



### **“Italian” Prune Dwarf Tree**

Latin Name: *Prunus* “Italian”

Description: Medium, purplish black sweet. Excellent fresh, canned or drying, resists cracking.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 10-12 feet with pruning.

Self Pollinating: Yes

Blooming Season: Early Spring

Harvest: Early September

Years to Fruit: 2-4yrs.

Freestone: Yes

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun, in fertile, well drained soil.



### **“Satsuma” Plum Dwarf Tree**

Latin Name: *Prunus salicina* “Satsuma”

Description: a large Japanese variety of dark, solid red skin and dark red flesh. The fruit is firm and juicy.

Flower Colour: Pink or White

Height: 10-14 ft.

Self Pollinating: No

Blooming Season: Mid Spring

Harvest: Late July to Early August

Years to Fruit: 2-4yrs.

Freestone: semi freestone

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun, in fertile, well drained soil.



### **“Shiro” Plum Dwarf Tree**

Latin Name: *Prunus salicina* "Shiro"

Description: Yellow skin covers sweet, juicy flesh. Heat-tolerant.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 12-15 ft.

Self Pollinating: Yes, but produce heavier crops when cross-pollinated with another Japanese plum tree.

Blooming Season: Early Spring

Harvest: Late July

Years to Fruit: 2-4yrs.

Freestone: No

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun, in fertile, well drained soil.



### **“Stanley Plum” Dwarf Tree**

Latin Name: *Prunus domestica* "Stanley"

Description: European plum. Fruit skin is a deep purple colour, the flesh is bright yellow. Fruit is great for eating right off the tree or for drying.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 8-10 ft.

Self Pollinating: Yes

Blooming Season: April

Harvesting: September

Years to Fruit: 3-5yrs.

Freestone: Yes

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun with fertile well drained soil.



### **“Yellow Egg” Plum Dwarf Tree**

Latin Name: *Prunus domestica* 'Yellow Egg'

Description: European plum. Produces an abundance of large, oval, freestone, golden yellow fruit with a golden interior that tastes like honey. Has juicy flesh and is very sweet and is grown for the outstanding quality of the fruit which is excellent for dessert, cooking, and canning.

Flower Colour: White

Height: 15 ft.

Self Pollinating: Yes

Blooming Season: Mid Spring

Harvest: September

Years to Fruit: 2-4yrs.

Freestone: Yes

Planting Instructions: Plant in full sun. Plums are quite adaptable to many soil types but they do best in well drained, fertile soils.
